This Trust has been set up by the Penrith Agricultural Society from the proceeds of the sale of the book about farming in Eden “Guardians of Eden”.

The Trust will award a bursaries to young people for developmental agricultural activity and initiatives.

Rules for Awards

1. Areas of agricultural activity and initiatives -
 - Promotion of Agricultural Produce and Skills
 - Agricultural inventions and innovations
 - Travel to see other agricultural practices
 - Links to other areas in relation to agriculture
2. Nominees should be 40 or under in age on the date of the application.
3. Nominees should live in the Eden District Council area.
4. Applications will be reviewed by the Trustee when applications received.
5. Applications should be supported by two references – one being a professional – eg bank manager, accountant or solicitor.
6. The level of Awards will be up to a maximum of £500.
7. The Awards will be made during the year once agreed by the Trustees.
8. Successful applicants should give a report on their agricultural work and activity to the Trustees which –
 - will illustrate what they have been doing and
 - can be shown at subsequent Penrith Shows and in promotional material
9. The Trustees have the final say in the Awards
