4. If there are less than 4 entries in any Class the judge will decide which prizes will be awarded.
5. Any exhibits not shown in the proper Class will be disqualified.
6. Exhibits to be staged by 9.30 am on the morning of the Show. The marquee will be closed for judging from 10.00 to 12.30 and closes again at 4.30 pm after which time the exhibitors must remove their exhibits. No responsibility can be accepted for exhibits not removed by 5.00 pm. NO EXHIBITS TO BE REMOVED BEFORE 4.30pm
7. Exhibitors to provide their own vases etc.
8. After judging the exhibits will be wired off to prevent them being handled by visitors to the Show.
9. All prize money to be collected in the Tent on Show Day from 4.30pm.
10. Presentation of Cup's at 4.00 pm
